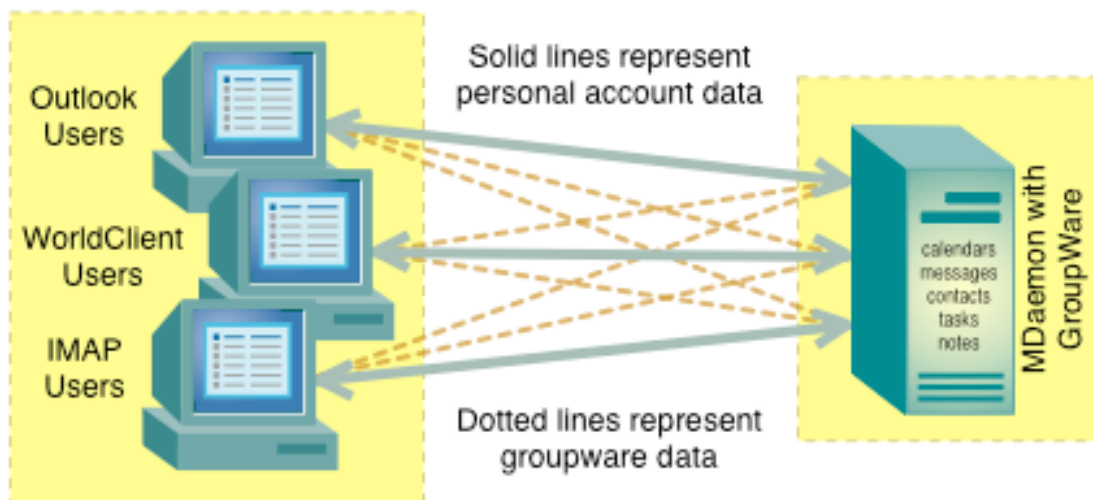


Groupware Functions in MDAemon

Group Sharing Benefits and Features

Software used by workgroups allows people to create and share information collaboratively. One simple application consists of sharing contacts and email addresses through a common address book. For more complex projects, group sharing allows controlled outside access to individuals' calendars, task lists, email messages and more.

Sharing with WorldClient, Outlook and IMAP

The groupware functions of MDAemon provide facilities for sharing calendars, email, contacts, and task lists, plus user-defined content contained in IMAP folders.

The groupware functions are available through the web mail applications of MDAemon's WorldClient.

For people who use the legacy Outlook application, Outlook Connector by Alt-N connects the collaborative functions of Outlook, to the groupware capabilities of MDAemon.

Whichever program they are using, MDAemon account holders can access the same information from Outlook or WorldClient. In addition, shared folders are available through any email client with IMAP capabilities.

Like the rest of MDAemon, group sharing is easy to configure, use and maintain. It provides easy first-time setup and grows along with the user's needs and skills.

Sharing and Security

While sharing is important, so is protecting information from unauthorized access or tampering.

As part of its security measures, MDAemon's groupware functions provide detailed control over shared access rights. Options range from making a folder invisible to a user to providing complete administrative control.
